## **Activities of Department of Computer Science under EDC**

Following are the various activities held in Department of Computer Science under EDC:

### 1. Projects

### a. "Sidechain" by Mr. Alexander Rodrigues, SYBSc

This project focuses primarily on the music community. This project is for individual musicians as well as music groups to use to get their talent recognised and can serve as a starting point for many such people who have no idea where to begin from.

# b. "SmartAgro" by Mr.Praveen Adithya, Mr.Valdo Fernandes, Mr.Hrishikesh Khedekar, Mr.Vedank Naik

This project focuses mainly on smart farming techniques with the use of digital electronics. It also focuses on automation in farming techniques like sprinkling / irrigation systems, soil management and water quality management and much more to help farmers by making agriculture easier and smarter.

In the starting phase, students are aiming to achieve the following features (PROTOTYPE):

- a. Water quality management (turbidity, Ph levels, alkalinity)
- b. Automatic Water storage control (storing in tank / sump)
- c. Automated sprinkling based on real-time soil moisture levels.

On the successful completion of the basic phase, they will explore their advanced phase:

- a. Mobile app for real-time remote control/info-sharing / updates on the farming land.
- b. Pest control, flood alerts
- c. Growth monitoring, animal intrusion detection etc.

#### **Further Scope:**

- a. Automated watering can be implemented in other public or private gardens/nursery/household plants.
- b. Commercial complexes or regular apartments and household tanks can be the target market to implement automated tank storage control as well.
