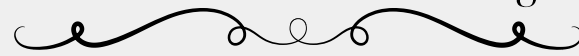

ACTIVITIES ORGANIZED

The Department of Economics organised an intercollegiate event titled "Ecoverse" on 22nd January 2026. The chief guests were Ms Mavish Banducda, an entrepreneur at Wishlist, and Mr Pranav Chimulkar, of Chimulkar Financial Services.

The event featured a variety of competitions, including quizzes, debates, policy-making, Shark Tank-style pitching, poster-making, photography, infographic design, data analytics, and meme creation, all based on different areas of economics.

A total of 5 colleges, 80 students and 9 faculty members attended the event.



The Department of Economics organised a study tour to Mangalore from 22nd to 25th February 2026 to provide students with experiential learning and institutional exposure. A total of 11 students participated in the tour under the guidance of Mr Ramu Pagi and Ms Renuka Sagvekar, Assistant Professors. The Department of Economics organised a subject talk on "Economic Growth and Physical Infrastructure" on 05 March 2026 at 2:30 PM in the Upper Auditorium.

Shri Raghudatha S. Pai Panandikar, Team Leader at Jaiman Constructions & Consultants LLP, delivered the session. During the talk, the speaker highlighted the crucial role of physical infrastructure, such as roads, transport networks, and development projects, in promoting economic growth and regional development. Drawing from his professional experience, including work on the four-laning of NH-66 in Goa, he explained the importance of infrastructure planning, quality standards, and efficient project management.

The session provided students with practical insights into infrastructure development, quality assurance standards, and their economic implications. The talk was interactive and helped students connect theoretical economic concepts with real-world infrastructure projects. A total of 51 students and 3 faculty members attended the session.
